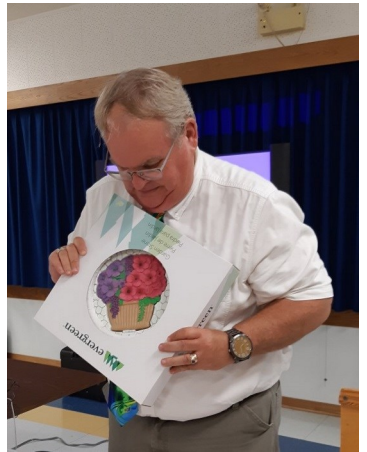

I would like to begin this update by thanking the Lions of District N2 for their swift and meaningful responses to the damage caused by Hurricane Fiona. Service to the community is the reason for our collective being and hopefully we will be able to collect all the information about that service on MyLion. It is important for Lions Clubs International, our community members and our fellow Lions to know how we responded to the incredible needs in the affected communities. Thanks to the work of LCIF Chair Susan Taylor and the district team, I am happy to share that District N2 has received a \$10,000 US Disaster Grant which will focus on the Glace Bay area to assist with the purchase of essential supplies for many families. Glace Bay Lions will manage this activity with the assistance of the District and I thank those folks who already have or will step up to help their fellow citizens.

I also want to thank the Lions of Lake Echo who hosted our Fall Cabinet on October 1st. It was unfortunate that many of our members were unable to attend due to the ongoing effect of Hurricane Fiona but we can hope for better attendance at the Winter Cabinet in Bedford.

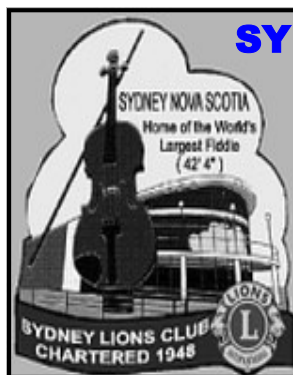

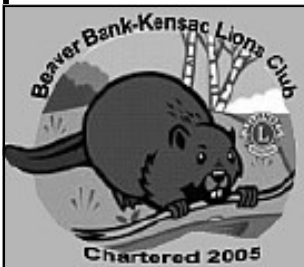
